Attendance

The latest attendance data has been collated by the Ministry of Education, and it is quite surprising. The most absences recorded are those children who are taking holidays during term time.

For our school, it is disturbing, as we know just how many children have been sick. Please be aware that the only authorised holidays in term time are for those families in the Military - all others are recorded as absences that are NOT JUSTIFIED.

Taking holidays in school time impacts on your child in many ways - socially with their friendship groups, and academically, as they miss key learning opportunities. Even though the curriculum is cyclic in nature, some concepts and key learning are not taught every year, and your child might not have that opportunity again for another two years to access this learning, thereby creating gaps in their knowledge.
