COVID-19 Updates

From Ministry of Health under Level 1 and the Ministry of Education

- \Rightarrow Teachers are cleaning their tables every day if not twice a day
- \Rightarrow Hand sanitizer at every entry point
- \Rightarrow Please reinforce with your child the importance of washing their hands with soap, and completely drying them.
- \Rightarrow Show them how to blow their nose, and dispose of the tissues, also how to sneeze into their elbow.
- \Rightarrow Make sure your child has their own tissues at school in their bag for their own use.
- \Rightarrow Please remind your child not to share their food and to keep their drink bottle to themselves.
- \Rightarrow In a school environment, we need to be extra-vigilant.

If your child shows any symptoms of being unwell, keep them at home. If your child becomes unwell at school, they will be in the sick bay and will need to be collected immediately.

A few parents have asked whether we are going to return to normal, now that we are at Level 1, as they are missing the social interactions with parents during pick -up times. Other parents have been keen to share that they love the drop-off in

the morning as they can then get on with their day, and the knock-on effect has been less cars around school and less congestion on adjoining roads. A win for 'walk into Wykeham'.

After school has been harder especially with the weather influences. We have found the independence of the seniors walking home first, has seen an increase in their confidence to be organised to leave with all their belongings, and to meet up with their parents off the school site. A great learning curve in readiness and preparation for Intermediate School.

The juniors have shown great courage as they have mastered which gate they leave from, and getting their belongings organised for going home. Their independence is shining through.

But, we will be trialling:

Moving forward for the last week of term, we will be continuing with the morning drop off at the gates, as it sets the children up for the day of learning and gives the teachers the opportunity to sort out any issues they might have.

If any parents want to collect their children from the school grounds, then the gates will be open at 2:55pm. We ask that you wait in the courtyards and not sit on the benches outside the classrooms, (as this distracts the children) for your children to come out to you with their bags and belongings. Lastly, could you please not allow your pre-schoolers to play on the playgrounds. Thank you.

The school bell will ring at 3:00pm for school to end. Children who walk home alone, can leave by the Wykeham gate as the new 'normal' and go home. Teachers will still be on the gates at Archers Rd and Chartwell Ave for parents who wish to collect them from their new 'normal' gates. At the 3-Way Conferences could you please let your child's teacher know where you will be collecting your child, or if they have permission to walk home independently.

A second bell will ring at 3:10pm for all parents and children to leave the school grounds. The gates will then be locked after this to ensure that our site remains clean for the next days learning and activities.

New Enrolments—Proposed enrolment zone
