## Proposed Enrolment Scheme (zone)

I think there may be some confusion in our community over the timing of the proposed enrolment scheme.

9 June The consultation period started and lasts 4 weeks.

13 July The paperwork and correspondence is sent to the Ministry of

Education.

13-17 July The Ministry of Education considers the feedback and approves

the Scheme.

29 July The Board of Trustees meet to ratify the scheme prior to notifying

the public.

September The Board of Trustees advise parents of the likely number of 'Out

of Zone' places available for the following year.

October Deadline for 'Out of Zone' applications (exact date to be

determined). Ballot is held.

#### Prior to the Ballot being drawn: -

Applications are sorted into the following six priority groupings (as set down by the Ministry of Education):

- Applicants accepted for a special programme
   ("This priority category is not applicable at this school because the school does not run a special programme approved by the Secretary")
- 2. Siblings of current students
- 3. Siblings of former students
- 4. Children of former students
- 5. Children of Board employees or Board members
- 6. All other applicants

Successful applicants are notified in writing in 3 days of ballot being drawn. Unsuccessful applicants are notified in writing in 3 days of ballot being drawn and also notified of their number on the school's waiting list.

Term 1, 2021 - The enrolment scheme comes into effect.

Instructions relating to the operation of enrolment schemes are available on the Ministry of Education's website, or a copy is available to look at, at the School Office.
